Class of 2010 Post-Baccalaureate Status Report
Executive Summary

The Post-Baccalaureate Status Report includes information collected from the Undergraduate College class of 2010 6-12 months after graduation. The data was obtained from the graduates through an on-line survey, email follow-up, LinkedIn and Facebook contacts, and through contact with faculty members.

A total of 275 graduates were surveyed resulting in a response from 168, thus representing 61% of the class of 2010. The graduates surveyed were identified as earning their Bachelor of Arts degree in the 2009-2010 academic year (December 09 + May and August 10) by the Office of Institutional Research.

- ✓ Of the 168 who responded, 150 (89%) graduates are employed full-time, attending graduate school, or participating in a long-term volunteer placement. 14 (8%) graduates are employed part-time and 4 (2%) graduates were not employed but seeking employment at the time they completed the survey.
- ✓ Overall, 44 (26%) of the survey respondents are continuing education either part-time or full-time. 26% is up 2 points from prior year (24% in 2009, 34% in 2008, and 35% in 2007).
- ✓ Of those continuing education, type of degree remains fairly steady: 85% of graduates are pursuing a master's degree (77% in 2009); 11% M.D., J.D. and other professional (up from 3% in 2009); 2% Certificate (3% in 2009); and 2% pursuing another Bachelor's degree (3% in 2009).
- ✓ 5 graduates (3%) indicated long term service as their primary activity.
- ✓ Of 94 graduates who responded to the survey's inquiry about the level of satisfaction with their job satisfaction, 83 (88%) reported being very satisfied or moderately satisfied with their current positions.
- ✓ Of the 72 graduates who reported their salary and who are working full-time, the median range was \$30,001 - \$32,500.
- ✓ The geographic distribution of the responding 2010 graduates shows 98 (58%) residing in Minnesota, 20 (12%) in Illinois, 11 (7%) in Wisconsin and the other 39 (23%) residing in 21 different states and 2 countries.
