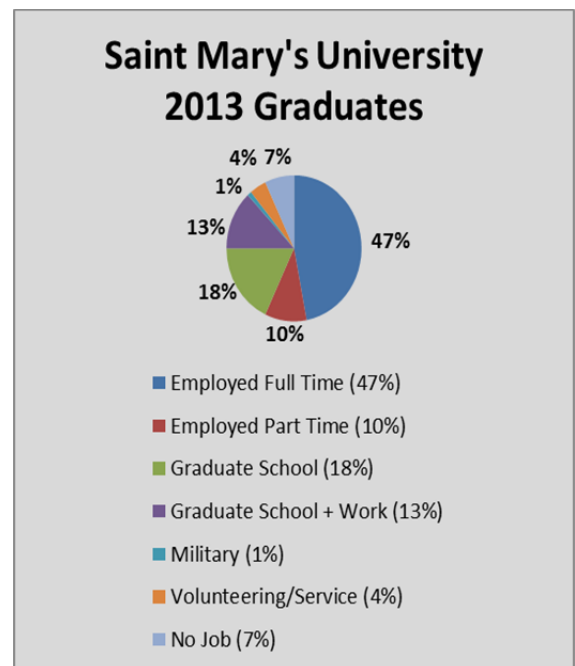

Class of 2013 Post-Baccalaureate Status Report
Executive Summary

The Career Services and Internship Office provides programs, activities, and individual career advising to assist students in developing a general perspective of life/work planning, as well as evaluating and effectively implementing specific job search strategies. The Post-Baccalaureate Status Report includes information collected from the Undergraduate College class of 2013 6-12 months after graduation. The data was obtained from the graduates through an on-line survey, email follow-up, and a postcard mailing.

A total of 254 graduates were surveyed resulting in a response from 106, thus representing 42% of the class of 2013. The graduates surveyed were identified as earning their Bachelor of Arts degree in the 2012-2013 academic year (December 12 + May and August 13) by the Office of Institutional Research.

- ✓ Of the 106 who responded, 83% are employed full-time (47%), are attending graduate school (31%), participating in a long-term volunteer placement (4%) or serving in the military (1%). 10% of graduates are employed part-time and 7% graduates were not employed but seeking employment at the time they completed the survey.
- ✓ Overall, 33 (31%) survey respondents are continuing education either part-time or full-time (20% in 2012, 25% in 2011, 26% in 2010, 24% in 2009, and 34% in 2008).
- ✓ Of those continuing education, 70% of graduates are pursuing a master's degree; 18% M.D., J.D. or other professional; and 12% Certificate.
- ✓ 4 graduates (4%) indicated long term service as their primary activity.
- ✓ The geographic distribution of the responding 2013 graduates shows 66 (62%) residing in Minnesota, 12 (11%) in Illinois, 12 (11%) in Wisconsin and the other 16 (15%) residing in 8 different states and three different countries.
