

30 SECOND COMMERCIAL

A 30 second commercial is a brief yet powerful way to introduce yourself, your brand, your skills, and interests to people you would meet in your career. It can be used at the beginning of a networking meeting, or can be expanded to answer the most commonly asked interview question, "Tell me about yourself."



Questions to Think About in developing your 30-second commercial

1. What are your short-term and long-term career goals?
2. What skill, strength, or experience do you have that would help you realize your goal?
3. What accomplishments/ experience proves you have that skill, strength, or interest?
4. What are you searching for in a job or internship experience?
5. How can you immediately benefit the program?
